The Residential New Homes Construction (RNHC) program supports all-electric new homes in Colorado, aligning with our clean energy and decarbonization goals.

How to earn rebates

The program offers rebates for all-electric homes that meet Department of Energy Zero Energy Ready Homes and ENERGY STAR® NextGen requirements. Larger incentives are also available for achieving more ambitious envelope requirements and certifications. To help achieve these high-performance standards, we will work with Residential Science Resources (RSR) to provide customers with design assistance and verify rebate requirements through energy modeling and field inspections.

This does not replace the need for an energy rater if you currently use one for code compliance, ENERGY STAR, or ZERH certification, including the 45L builder tax credits. RSR will verify the RNHC rebate requirements but will not provide code verification, tax credit support, or above-code certifications.
